

Tariq Rauf (Canada) presently is the Director of the Disarmament, Arms Control and Non-Proliferation Programme at SIPRI. He was Senior Advisor to the Chair of Main Committee I (nuclear disarmament) at the 2015 NPT Review Conference and also to the Chair of the 2014 Preparatory Committee for the 2015 Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT) Review Conference.

From 2002 to 2011, he was Head of Verification and Security Policy Coordination, at the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), in which capacity he dealt with high-priority verification cases involving Iran, Iraq, Libya, North Korea, South Korea and Syria, as well as safeguards implementation in all countries, including promoting accession to the Additional Protocol and Comprehensive Safeguards Agreements; he worked on the Amendment to the Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material (CPPNM) and on nuclear security.

Tariq was also the Alternate Head of the IAEA Delegation to NPT Conferences and PrepComs from 2003 to 2010, and the IAEA Liaison and Point-of-Contact for multilateral control regimes such as the Nuclear Suppliers Group and UNSCR 1540, United Nations Security Council committees, and the Counter-Terrorism Implementation Task Force (CTITF).

Tariq has a strong connection to Canada. He was Senior Associate and Research Director at the Canadian Centre for Arms Control and Disarmament in Ottawa, from 1986 to 1995. From 1987 to 2000, he was Non-Proliferation Expert/Advisor with Canada's delegations to NPT Conferences.
